1. The registration fee for the derby **does not** include any **Recreation Area or marina fees**.

Your entry in the derby makes you eligible for door prizes to be given away at the Sunday Awards Program at 1:00 p.m. at the Fireside Theater. You must be present to win door prizes.

THE RULES

1. **Current** Nature Center, park and concessionaire staff, volunteers, hosts and any of their immediate families **may not participate** in the Fish Derby.

2. Only individuals 4 years old or older, who have paid a registration fee and have a valid DERBY ID BADGE, are eligible to win. The Derby ID Badge must be worn in a visible location above the waist during derby fishing hours.

3. Participants must possess a valid California fishing license (except for those under 16 years of age) and follow all California Department of Fish and Wildlife regulations. Participants must use sport fishing equipment. **Use of commercial fishing devices, or fishing in restricted areas will result in immediate disqualification.**

4. The derby fishing **begins at 6 a.m. on October 17, 2020 and ends at 12 noon on October 18, 2020.** Contestants must fish in Cachuma Lake during the tournament hours and may fish from shore at any time during the derby including Saturday night. A flare will be fired at the harbor to start the derby on Saturday and to end the derby on Sunday.

5. Each person registered in the derby is eligible to win one of the donated door prizes and must be present at the Sunday Awards Program to win a door prize. A person need not be present to win the raffle prizes or the guaranteed cash prizes.

6. If the lake is closed due to **high winds or other weather conditions**, registrants may continue to fish from shore. Check www.sbparks.org for current Wind Guidelines at Cachuma Lake.

7. **Fish Registration:** Present the fish you caught (in Cachuma Lake) along with your official Derby ID Badge to the officials at the **Weigh-in Station** during the following hours:

6 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. on Saturday, October 17, 2020 and
6 a.m. to 12 noon on Sunday, October 18, 2020.

Gutted fish will not be accepted for judging or qualify for prizes.

8. **Ties** between fish of equal weight will be decided by the longest length. Stomach contents are subject to examination.

9. Verification of fish awards will be made by Fish Derby officials, whose decisions will be final.

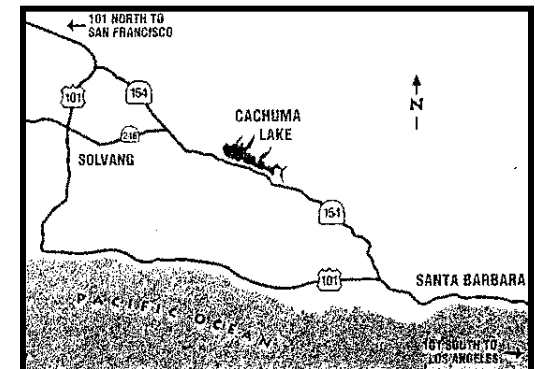
