- 9. <u>ACC</u> Steve Counsell reported 2 ACC notices were sent out in the past month. One has been resolved and the other one is still pending.
- 10. <u>Facilities</u>—Greg Tipton reported that the jacuzzi was currently not working due to a bad motor, but the motor is still under warranty.
- 11. <u>Community Liaison Report</u>-Suzie Cary reported that the Newsletter is still primary focus as well as supporting our Board President and the ACC when needed. She is open to ideas for future Newsletters from residents.

### **Ongoing Business**
