- 6. <u>Secretary report</u> –Jennifer Ramsden reported that she gets emails from residents regarding several different topics, and she tries to address them all or refer residents to the correct Board Member.
- 7. <u>Web Content</u> –Lori Huckle reported she has loaded new photos to our website including monthly Board Agendas, Newsletters and Financials.
- 8. <u>Real Estate</u> Lori Huckle there is nothing new to report. We have had 4 home closings this year with no homes currently on the market.
- ACC Steve Counsell reported that 10 actionable items were handled the month of September. Three Courtesy Letters were sent out with all Residents responding. Seven total ACC requests came in, one involving the COS Historical Committee as well as the City of Scottsdale Planning and Zoning Department.

The grass is dead as well some trees. It was determined through a conversation with the COS that Scottsdale Monterey, the development on the east side of 78th Street, has been and is the responsible party for the maintenance of the median.
- B. <u>VM 6 Neighborhood Maintenance:</u> The Board is keeping an eye on the maintenance of yards and carports. If there are any concerns by the Board or Residents, the Neighborhood Complaint Form can be filled out and given to the Board to address. You can find this form on our website.
