I understand I need to secure private insurance if I wish to have my work(s) insured.

REGULATIONS:

Invited artists may register one piece. Artists that wish to be considered, but have not been invited by their league or by LIFAI, may enter one piece to be juried into the exhibition.

Work may not be labelled NFS. **Pay close attention to the size limitations on the piece you are entering.**

If size requirements are not adhered to when measured at drop off, fees may be forfeited. No refunds once registered. No changes may be made after the April 17, 2026 deadline. All entries must remain for the duration of the show. If work is not picked up on the closing date, and prior written arrangements weren't made between the Artist and LIFAI, the Artist will be charged a Five-dollar storage fee per day and the work will be considered abandoned after 72 hours.

ELIGIBILITY:

Any two 2-dimensional work which is original in concept, composition and independently executed in mediums such as oil, acrylic, watercolor, pastel, graphite, pen and ink, or mixed media. All work must be an original creation of the artist, labelled and hand delivered, along with your signed waiver. Each must be quality framed and completely ready for hanging with wire (no saw-tooth hangers). Work that is not properly presented, requires special handling, or is deemed inappropriate by the library or Show Committee, may be rejected. No digital, computer art, photography or mechanical reproductions such as giclees or lithographic reproductions of original works in other media will be accepted unless as part of a collage or mixed media work. No AI artwork is acceptable.

Sales:

Artists receive 70% of the sale of their work, 15% will be allocated to the hosting organization, 15% to Long Island Cares, Inc.
