Meet Sean Duffy

Born and raised in Montgomery County, Sean stayed in Pennsylvania for college, graduating from Temple University with a political science degree and then earning a law degree from Villanova. He began his professional career as a police officer in Cape May, New Jersey, where he spent more than six years on the force. That practical foundation led him to serve as a commissioned officer in the United States Army with the elite 82nd Airborne Division at Fort Bragg. Most notably, he served as Chief of National Security Law for Division Headquarters, where he advised Commanders and staff on operational law. There, he provided legal counsel to more than 18,000 soldiers on everything from ethics and investigations to operational law. In August 2021, he deployed unexpectedly to Kuwait to support Operation Allies Refuge. After his military service, Sean returned to Pennsylvania and built a respected legal practice in Bucks County focusing



on the very issues that matter most to us: land development, open space preservation and responsible infrastructure decisions. The 29th District deserves a representative who understands both the big picture in Harrisburg and the day-to-day realities of our neighborhoods. Sean Duffy has spent his life preparing for exactly this role.

In a quiet office plaza in Los Angeles, a single building serves as the registered address for some 89 different hospice companies.

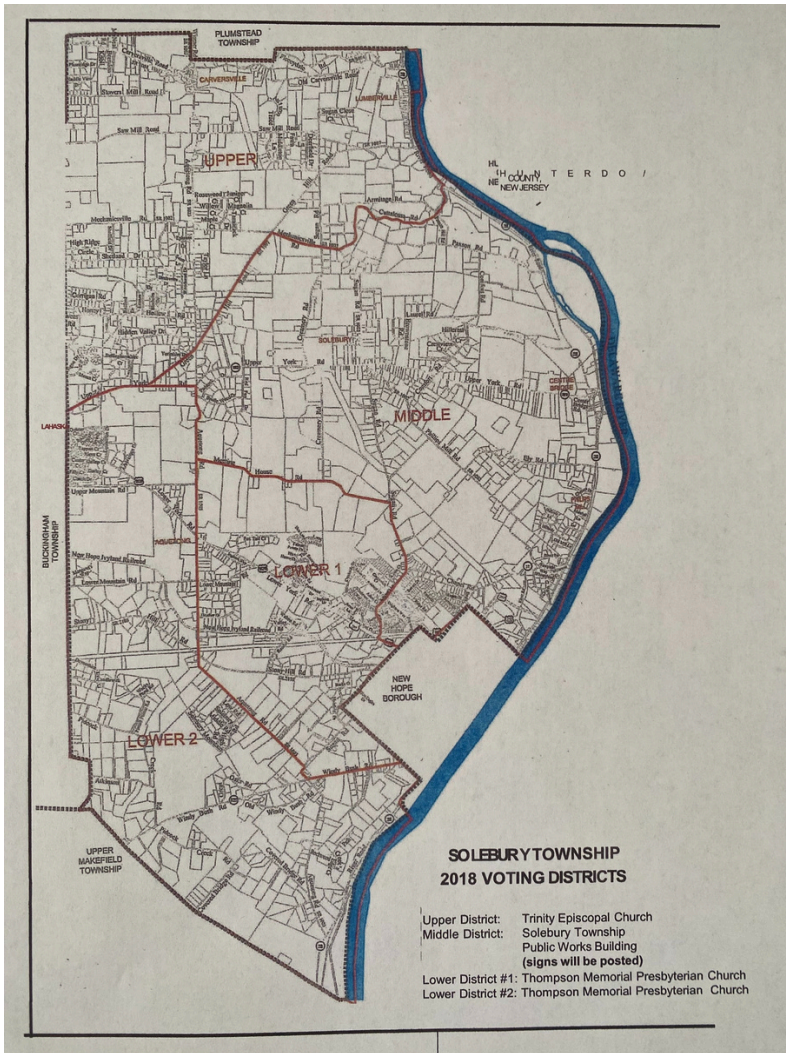
