

invade women's locker rooms. In pandering to less than 1% of the population, President Biden has endangered the 51% with the stroke of a pen.



Additional "benefits" from Title IX

Removal of Due Process

Also written into this new version of Title Nine is the removal of the right to a free trial if someone on a college campus is accused of sexual assault. The right to a fair hearing and the right for the defendant to confront the accuser or even offer exonerating evidence will be removed. Under Title IX, an accusation of wrongdoing equates to guilt.

The revisions are set to take effect August 1st, though 26 states are currently fighting back. Moms for Liberty has created a Fact Sheet with Calls to Action that can be accessed <u>here</u>. Enough is enough and we need to fight for our children that are here now.
