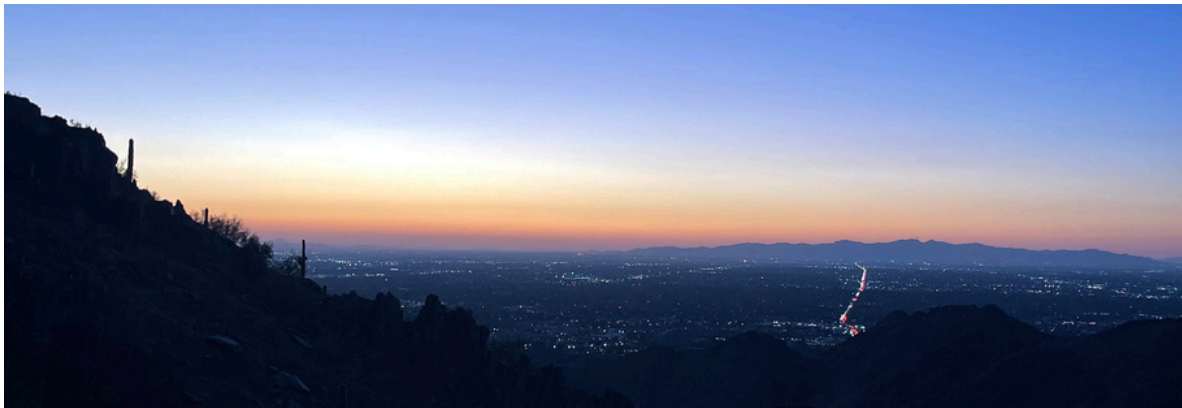




GUIDED TOUR QUARTZ RIDGE SUNSET HIKING
