



## TIM DEMPSEY

### CLASS OF 1978

Tim Dempsey is a member of the class of 1978 of Point Pleasant High School. During his years at Point High, he participated in varsity soccer, basketball and track. As a member of the soccer team he attained All Conference, All County and All State honors. He also attained All Conference and All County honors in basketball. Tim was also Vice President of the Key Club for three years, and a member of The National Honor Society. In his senior year he was voted the Outstanding Male Athlete.

Upon graduation from high school, Tim attended Glassboro State (now Rowan University) graduating Magna Cum Laude in 1982 with a Bachelor's Degree in Health and Physical Education. At Glassboro he was a member of the 1981 NCAA Division



III National Champion soccer team. He was named to the Division III All American Team that same year. In his senior year he was named the Athlete of the Year and has been inducted into the Glassboro State Hall of Fame.

From 1983 thru 1984 he attended Western Illinois University where he earned 30 credits toward a Master of Science in Exercise Science, and was a Graduate Assistant Men's Soccer Coach.

Tim returned to Point Pleasant from 1984 thru 1988 as a Health and Phys Ed teacher. He was an assistant coach in several sports and was the Key Club Advisor.

In 1989, Tim left Point Pleasant to become the Women's Soccer and Basketball coach and Assistant Athletic Director at Green Mountain College in Vermont. His soccer teams have won 10 Conference Championships, 4 District Championships, 3 Regional Championships, and have made 2 National Championship appearances. His basketball teams have won 5 Conference Championships. Tim has been named Conference Coach of the Year 8 times for soccer and 5 times for basketball. He also worked for 19 years as a summer camp clinician.

He is a member of the National Soccer Coaches of America and an active member of the United Methodist Church of Poultney, Vermont. He is married to Heather Dempsey (Sutton) and they have three children, Colleen, Ryan and Erin.
