Sean P. Fahey is a 1987 graduate of Point Pleasant High School. During high school, Mr. Fahey was a Student Council Officer, Class Officer, and Key Club Officer. Sean also found time to play Football and Basketball.

Mr. Fahey earned his undergraduate degree in Political Science (with a Philosophy Minor), from Villanova University in 1991. During college, he was a member of the Pi Sigma Alpha Honor Society and made the Dean's List during his Junior and Senior years. He was also a member of the Blue Key Society and was deeply involved in Villanova's Special Olympics program, serving as the volunteers chairperson his Senior year. He was an Orientation Counselor for three years and was also on the Steering Committee for the Orientation program. Mr. Fahey was the Rush Chairman for his fraternity -Pi Kappa Alpha- and was voted into Villanova's

Mr. Fahey earned his law degree from Villanova University School of Law in 1994. While at law school, he was a Class Officer and Executive Officer for the Student Bar Association. He also created an orientation program at the Law School for 1 st year law students. He currently serves as the Chairman of his Class Giving Committee and is an executive officer of the Villanova University School of Law Alumni Association.

Mr. Fahey's admission ceremony - held in the Court's Chamber's - was presided over by William H. Rehnquist, Chief Justice of the United States. Associate Justices Breyer, Ginsburg, Kennedy, O'Connor, Scalia, Stevens, Souter and Thomas were also in attendance. As a member of the Bar, Mr. Fahey is now permitted to argue cases before the Supreme Court of the United States.
