Before graduating from Point Pleasant Borough High School in 1978, Russ Leming made his mark on the football field. During his sentor year Russ was elected to the *New York Daily News* All State Team and the *Asbury Park Press* All Shore Team. WOBM Radio chose him twice as the player of the week and offensive player of the year. Russ helped Ocean County to a huge victory over Monmouth County in the inaugural All Star game. Russ was also named Ocean County leading scorer, ground gainer and Player-of-the-Year in 1978.

Since graduating from high school, Russ passed his love and knowledge of sports on to youngsters of all ages. He has had success in coaching youth basketball and soccer and in the Junior All American football league in Southern California.
