



Dry Wine List

(From least dry on top to Most dry on bottom)

8. Isabella- Similar to a rose' in color and character, Isabella is a fun and enjoyable light-bodied wine. 11.9% ABV \$14/bottle

9. DeChaunac- Pronounced (deSHAWNac) this hybrid grape produces a rich and fruity medium-dry wine. Medium-bodied with balanced acidity and a uniquely tart finish. Enjoy slightly chilled year-round as a companion to savory or sweet dishes. 12% ABV \$13/bottle

10. Chardone- This dry white wine is a French-American hybrid of Chardonnay and Seyval Blanc. We treated this wine as a Chardonnay; aging sur lies and in keeping with its KY heritage, it was aged in lightly toasted KY oak barrels. Best when served chilled. 12.3% ABV \$15/bottle

11. Baco Noir- This rich, dark, and tannic dry red wine displays flavors of vanilla, and cacao nibs. A leather aroma announces the tannins derived from the medium-toast French oak it was aged on. Enjoy year round and at room temperature. This wine will only improve with age. 12% ABV \$13/bottle

12. Seyval Blanc- Please ask for availability as this wine will be made available soon. This dry white wine has been aged in true tequilla barrels from Mexico adding a flavor of toasted oak, spice, and vanilla. This smooth dry white wine has complex floral aromas and a mouthfeel reminiscent of a fine tequilla. 15.2% ABV \$15/bottle

13. Big Red Blend- Please ask for availability as this wine will be made available soon. A 50-50 blend of Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon aged for one month in Bourbon Barrels from Franklin, KY. 13% ABV \$15/bottle
