(Sweetest on top to least sweet on bottom)

1. Sweet Tea- This unique creation is just what it sounds like. Made with real home-brewed Sweet Tea and a base of golden raisins, this fun wine invokes the southern lady or gent in all of us! Fresh lemons are evident help balance out and create a crisp, sweet, and delicious treat. Best when chilled or over ice! 9.8% ABV \$13/bottle

2. Strawberry- No other wines or fruit were used while making this southern classic. This strawberry wine has an aroma of fresh strawberry preserves. It is on the lusciously sweet end of the scale. 9.8% ABV \$14/bottle

3. Valvin Muscat- A French-American hybrid grape reminiscent of Moscato. Peach and orange blossom flavors are prevalent. This crisp white wine is very floral on the nose and best when served chilled. 10.9% ABV \$14/bottle

4. Concord- Rich, fruity, and jammy, this full-bodied red wine is a fan-favorite! 11% ABV \$13/bottle

5. BlackBerry- Made with fresh blackberries, this dark and fruity wine is just sweet enough to offset the tartness of the fruit. We wanted to recreate the sensation of biting into a fresh blackberry. Best when served chilled. 10.6% ABV \$15/bottle

6. Vignoles- This French-American hybrid grape produces a crisp and refreshing medium-sweet white wine. A luscious floral aroma with flavors of apricot and pineapple. Best when served chilled. 12.2% ABV \$13/bottle

7. Peach- Light and crisp medium-sweet fruit wine. This Peach wine is a refreshing treat that can be enjoyed year-round. Enjoy chilled. 10.5% ABV \$14/bottle
