

What To Expect At Summer Slam (AM)

Summer Slam #3 is at Roosevelt Lake on June 20th from first light to noon. We'll be at Windy Hill, Ringtail/Badger ramp.

Give the rules a good read over before the derby. Everyone will sign a waiver at their first event of the 2026 season. You only need to do ONE per season.

Our entry fee is \$200. Cash is king and counting out the amount before you get to Lyle makes the line move faster. Super Bass option is \$20 and a way to get in on even more big bass money.

Once you've checked in and got your boat slip from Lyle, and signed a waiver, you'll be ready to get your livewell checked and launch your boat. **Livewell checks are at the trailer.** Tell them the number on your boat slip and open the lids. You'll launch and wait on the water until we do blastoff.

The registration line will close at 4:45. If you show up at the end you will have to wait until after blastoff out of respect for the people waiting on the water that came early to be ready. We'll do the anthem, go over quick rules, shout out the sponsor, and call boat numbers shortly after. When you hear your boat number give a wave and it's go time. **Blastoff is at approximately 5am.**

Weigh in is drive thru. We have a weigh bag if you need one. Please say your name and boat number when you come up to the scale to help with speed and accuracy. Weights will be on the tv screen.

If you aren't weighing fish text Lyle at the phone number on your boat slip or check in at the trailer so we know you are safe and off of the water.

There will be a white board by the tv screen that tells how many places we will pay out.

We do awards and hand out the money after weighing in so stick around! See us before you leave so we can take your picture if you get a plaque.
