What To Expect At Weekend Warrior

We are looking forward to Weekend Warrior #3 at Fisher's Landing/Martinez on Saturday! We'll be at the end of the dirt parking lot area. We'll be there around 9:00 or so on Friday night if anyone wants to sign up early.

Give the rules a good read over before the weekend. Don't forget you need to be off of the water by dark on Friday night. Everyone will sign a new waiver at their first WWBS event of the season. You only need to do ONE per season.

Make sure that you are signed up for any boat rewards. There is a rewards and contingency tab on the website with links to help you out with that process. We are excited that our AZ region of Weekend Warrior is now Tier 1 in the Basscat Quest program!

Our entry fee is \$240. Cash is king and counting out the amount before you get to Lyle makes the line move faster. We have a few side options. Super Bass is \$20 and a way to get in on even more big bass money. We also have a \$20 option for the ladies. There will be a sign up sheet for Youth, Veterans, a Copper State Tackle & Marine receipt from the week prior to the Friday before the event (must have the proof of purchase with the date to show), BassCat and Caymas Boat list.

Coffee and doughnuts will be going by 4:30. Come early so you are ready to go when the registration line closes at 6:45am. Once you've checked in and got your boat slip from Lyle, grabbed some coffee & food, and signed everything, you'll be ready to get your livewell checked and launch your boat. Livewell checks are by the top of the ramp. Tell them the number on your boat slip and open the lids. You'll launch and wait on the water until we do blastoff.

The registration line will close 15 minutes prior to safelight. If you show up at the end you will have to wait until after blastoff out of respect for the people waiting on the water that came early to be ready. We'll do the anthem, go over quick rules, shout out the sponsors, and call boat numbers shortly after. When you hear your boat number give a wave and it's go time. **Blastoff is approximately 7:00am.**

Weigh in is drive thru. If you need a weigh bag we will have them on the sign about 4 or 5 spots back so you can get one and be ready before you pull up. Have your fish in the bag when you pull up and big fish tagged if you want it weighed.

One person will stay in the boat and hand off your fish bag to be weighed as you drive up. <u>Say your name and boat number</u> nice and loud when you pull up, even if we know you this helps with speed and accuracy. If you want a picture the driver can also get out and we'll take one for you quick. Please discuss this ahead of time so it speeds up the process and we keep the line flowing.

When you are done weighing in you'll park and come back and check the tv screen for your place and grab some food.

If you aren't weighing fish text Lyle at the phone number on your boat slip or check in at the trailer so we know you are safe and off of the water. Don't leave us hanging on that because we will try to reach you at the end and everyone else has to wait for us to make sure that you are OK.

There will be a white board by the tv screen that tells how many places we will pay out and the other prizes.

We do awards and hand out the money after weigh in so stick around! See us before you leave so we can take your picture if you get a plaque.
