## **High School**

### Supplies Included:

- 15 Rubber Ducks
- 9 Stickers
- 5 Keychains
- 1 \$10 Amazon Gift Card

### Directions:

- Hide 3 ducks per day (save the red bottom duck for Friday. This one is for the big prize.)
- When a student turns in a found duck, they get the prize coordinating with the bottom color and may keep the rubber duck
- Blue= pop-it, Green= sticker, Red= gift card

## **Middle School**

### Supplies Included:

- 11 Rubber Ducks
- 9 Stickers
- 5 Keychains
- 1 \$10 Amazon Gift Card

### Directions:

- Hide 2 ducks per day (save the red bottom duck for Friday. This is for the big prize)
- When a student turns in a found duck, they get the prize coordinating with the bottom color and may keep the rubber duck.
- Blue= pop-it, Green= sticker, Red= gift card
- Hide 3 ducks on Friday including the red-bottom duck

## **Elementary School**

### Supplies Included:

- 15 Rubber Ducks
- 15 Stickers
- 30 Paper Ducks

### Directions:

- Hide 6 duck printouts per day.
- If a duck is red, students receive a rubber duck
- If a duck is yellow, students receive a sticker
