High School Scholarship Application

The Dearborn County Community Advocating for Substance Abuse Awareness (CASA) would like to provide high school seniors with the opportunity to be awarded a \$500 scholarship. One student from each of our area high schools will be chosen (South Dearborn High School, Lawrenceburg High School, and East Central High School).

The requirements are as follows:

- * Student must be a Dearborn County high school senior.
- * Student should have a good attendance record.
- * School behavior records must be devoid of any school suspensions due to alcohol, tobacco, or other drug issues.
- * GPA should be at least a C average.
- * Student should be enrolled in an accredited college or technical school for the 2019-2020 school year

To apply:

- * Fill out the attached application. This must include a signature from your guidance counselor. Transcripts are NOT required.
 - * Submit an essay between 750-1000 words. Subject should be the student's perspective on alcohol, tobacco, or other drugs. This can be a national, state, or local perspective or a personal narrative on specific experiences. Why do you choose to be drug-free? What are the arguments to our community to address these issues? Or any similar themes pertaining to these issues. This essay should be typed.
- Applications should be postmarked by Monday, April 8, 2019.**
Awards will be announced on Monday, May 7, 2019.
