LastMile Asset Management is one of the leading Independent Distribution Network Operators (IDNOs) in the UK. Granite have been appointed to install equipment to their network including LV/HV cabling, feeder pillars, switchgear and associated civils from concept to commissioning.

The works include maintenance, replacing damaged equipment, upgrading and new installations.

Working closely with the designers and operational team to define work scope, Granite have been able to remove potential future issues. Resulting in accelerating programmes times to complete working on time and on budget.

Granite have also invested in regional depot nationally to provide stocks to be readily available which again reduces the lead items on items for installation.

Regular engagement meeting allows for look ahead of potential schemes and smooths resource profiling to stop potential labour shortages.





The collaborative relationship between LastMile and Granite has enabled elements of self determination of connections which again has reduced design time and also double handling of communication and decision making.



Granite was also able to recruit and develop staff through the contract including apprentice specifically to develop on these works from jointers mate to qualified Jointers.



This ongoing work stream has also been a test bed for cloud based site information to be stored and to potentially used in the future to support asset management.
