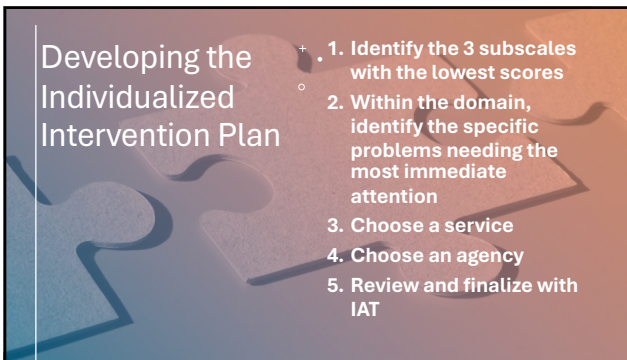
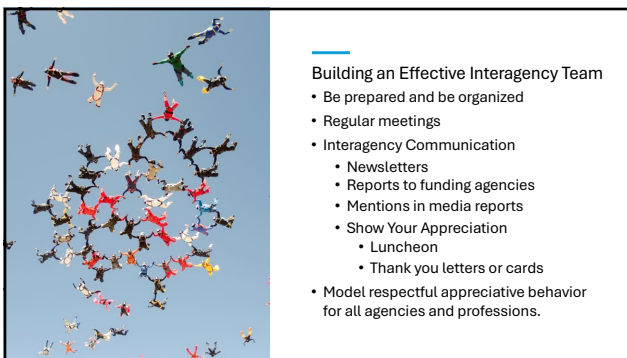

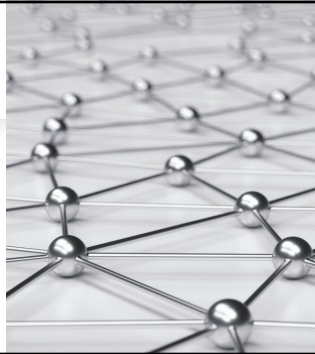

- Show respect for family preferences and values

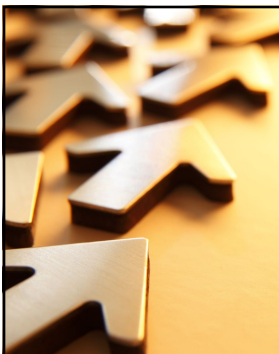

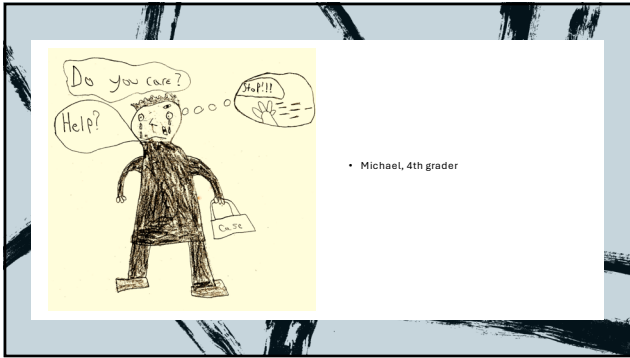
Tips for a Great IAT Meeting

- Show respect for all professions

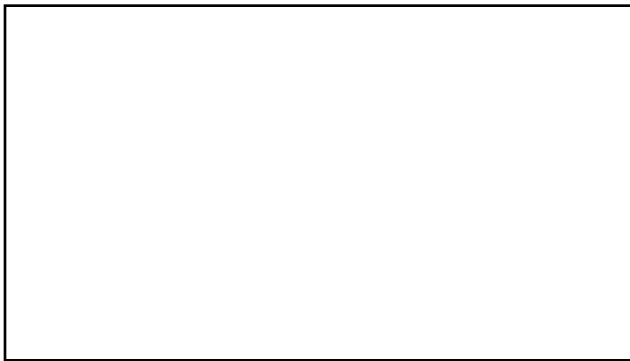
