The National Federation of Indian American Association (NFIA) in collaboration with the Kashmiris in Georgia (KIG) partnered to create NFIA-KIG Scholarship that provide financial assistance to college bound students who choose to pursue higher education. NFIA-KIG Scholarship lessens the financial burden on students and families. Scholarship is initially granted for one year and may be considered for up to four (4) years subject to availability of funds.

Successful applicants will receive \$ 1,000 annually in financial assistance up to \$4,000 for tuition and fees while enrolled in an accredited College, University or Technical School program (not to exceed a maximum 4-year period). The scholarship awards are made annually in August.

NFIA-KIG offers a total of three (3) scholarship: one (1) merit based (requirements GPA>3.5; SAT>1300; ACT >30) and two (2) merit cum means (requirement GPA>3.0; SAT>1200; ACT>27).

Applicants for merit cum means scholarship must provide accurate annual household income information. In case of US citizens, Green card holders or Non-resident Indians the annual household income needs to be less than \$75,000.

NFIA-KIG reserves the right to request tax returns for verification from applicants seeking merit cum means scholarship. Applicants (for merit cum means scholarships) residing in India or Indian citizens still need to provide annual household income in the currency of the resident for consideration by the review committee.

The NFIA-KIG Scholarship Review Committee will assess scholar's compliance with academic each semester. Scholarship may be discontinued or placed on hold for those quarters/semester when recipients are absent from College, University or Technical School.

The judging of new applicants will be based on review of the following required submittals:

- Demonstrated exceptional academic achievements determined by ACT/SAT scores, High School GPA, and /or current College transcripts.
  - For entering Freshman: ACT/SAT scores
  - For currently Enrolled Students: Copies of your current college/technical school transcript and /or cumulative GPA.
- Extra-Curricular and Leadership Activities
- Personal Essays
- Recommendation Letters
