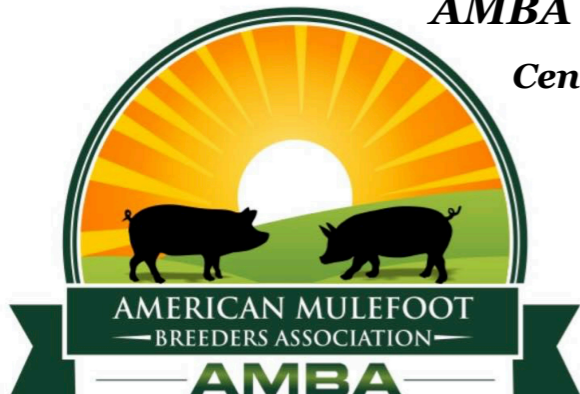

Sows with multiple Litters: please list Sow first with first farrowing of the year, and information from each subsequent Litter directly below. You may "ditto" columns A-G. Leave Columns H & I blank for Sow reporting.

Designate listed animal sex in Column C. Multiple animal listings can be reported on this form.

Weight is an important metric in defining the growth potential in any line. Use this form to report weights of Boar or Sow (Column F), and litters (Columns N & O). UNK for Unknown information.

Reporting Status (Column P): Live, Dead or Transferred at End of Year: L, D, or T.

Column G is for Grading the Paternal/Maternal Temperament of your Animal. Using a 1 - 3 Scale, with 1 calmest to 3 hardest to handle, select score that best represents each animal listing.

Paternal (Boars, Sires):

- 1 - calm with new sows, new handler, easy feeder, not a bully
- 2 - nervous or active with new sows, new handler or piglets
- 3 - aggressive to new sows, piglets or handler

Maternal (Sows, Dams):

- 1 - calm & attentive, may lose 1 during first farrowing, easy delivery
- 2 - upset with change, may crush 1 or 2 piglets each farrowing
- 3 - agitated, refuse to care for piglets, no milk, may kill piglets, needs assistance at each farrowing

(Exception to agitated scoring is when handler is trying to retrieve piglets to inspect, weigh, etc. Be aware that any animal with offspring can perceive a handler as danger.)
