The Friends of the St. Joe River Association (FotSJR) is offering financial assistance for the 2024 Indiana Watershed Leadership Academy (IWLA). The IWLA is organized by Purdue University and gives participants the opportunity to improve their watershed management skills and receive a Professional Certificate in Watershed Management. The program runs from January through May of 2024. It will include virtual group discussion sessions, distance learning modules to be completed on your own, and three face-to-face sessions.
