

Updated Covid-19 Screening Policy

Attention Riteway Parents & Staff:

As of **March 7, 2022** our Covid-19 Screening Policy has been updated as follows:

All parents will indicate verbally at drop off if their child does have a temperature or any COVID-19 related symptoms. If a parent is unable to verify this information, center staff will screen the child. All staff will also continue to report a self-screening upon entry.

Note:

- Children over 2 will continue to be encouraged to wear masks as long as they are comfortable until further notice
- STAFF WILL CONTINUE TO WEAR MASKS INSIDE THE BUILDING UNTIL AT LEAST APRIL 29,2022 AT WHICH POINT THIS POLICY WILL BE REVISITED
- Persons who have a fever of 100.4 (38.00C) or above, or other signs of COVID-19 illness as outlined in the Department of Health COVID-19 Public Health Recommendations for Operating Child Care Facilities, shall not be admitted to the facility.
- Center should be notified immediately if children or parents come into contact with anyone who has tested positive for Covid-19
- Per the local health department All child care center <u>staff must provide proof</u> of vaccination or evidence of weekly testing.

- UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE ONLY STAFF, STUDENTS, THERAPISTS AND THOSE WHO HAVE SPOKEN WITH THE DIRECTOR IN ADVANCE WILL CONTINUE TO BE ALLOWED INSIDE THE BUILDING EXCEPT BY APPOINTMENT ONLY.
