Wed., Sept. 20:** Enter and pay online with credit card, debit card, or PayPal by going to www.artworksbg.org and click on Exhibitions, then Members-Only.
- Thurs., Sept. 21:** Deliver your art piece(s) to Ellis Walker Gallery 2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- Sat., Sept. 30:** Opening Reception, 5:30 p.m. Awards presented at 6:00 p.m.
- Sat., Oct. 28:** Exhibit Ends - pick up art, 11:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. If you cannot pick up your art, or have someone pick up your art for you on this date, DO NOT ENTER.

ENTRY FEE: \$25 for one art piece

Entry fee must be paid online on or before September 20: www.artworksbg.org, click on EXHIBITIONS and then MEMBERS-ONLY to enter and pay online.

AWARDS: ArtWorks continues to offer the highest paid Best of Show award in the region - \$500.
Juror TBA Other Awards: "Myra Dwyer Award", "Newbie Award", 1st, 2nd, 3rd, & Merit in 2d and 3D categories. One "Best Amateur" will be awarded.

PRESENTATION GUIDELINES:

All works of art must be presented in a professional manner. Works intended for hanging must be properly prepared to hang professionally from a traditional wall hook. **WIRED BACKS ONLY FOR 2D - NO EXCEPTIONS.** Art with sawtooth hangers will not be accepted. Plexiglas is strongly recommended for works larger than 24 inches. If your 3D art needs a special hanging device, please bring it with you when you deliver your art.

Maximum size for 2D work is 50" horizontal/vertical. All 3D work must be stable and not weigh more than 100 pounds. Artists submitting works weighing more than 50 pounds must be on call to help with placement. **All 2D and 3D works of art must be solid and stable.** No video art accepted.

RULES:

Late entries are not allowed. If you did not sign up online/pay by September 20 your entry will not be accepted. Previous winning art from any ArtWorks, Inc. juried exhibition will not be eligible for awards. All entries must be original and completed within the last **TWO** years (2021-2023). Greenware, utilitarian kits and over the counter craft items are not eligible. No "Sip and Paint" themed art accepted. All works created from natural materials must be stable, well seasoned, and reptile/insect free. The ArtWorks' exhibition committee along with Ellis Walker gallery reserve the right to decline any work that does not fit the space.

LIABILITY:

Participating artists agree to hold harmless ArtWorks, Inc., the Exhibition Committee, Ellis Walker Gallery and its volunteers/employees/owners for any loss, theft, or damage that may occur while artwork is on display. Participating artists agree to grant permission to ArtWorks, Inc. and Ellis Walker Gallery to photograph or video installed artwork for advertising or social media purposes.

SALES:

All art sales will be made through the Ellis Walker Gallery. Art sold will remain in the gallery until the close of the exhibition. At the end of the exhibition artists will be paid their asking price minus a 35% commission allocated to the Ellis Walker Gallery. Artists are responsible for paying taxes on earnings. Buyers may pick up purchased art on October 28.

ART PICK UP:

All art will remain in the gallery until the end of the exhibition. If you are unable to pick up your art on October 28th, be sure to email artworksbgky@gmail.com and tell us who will. ArtWorks, Inc. does not ship art.

LABEL YOUR ART:

Use an index card, a piece of paper, your business card, or print out labels below and attach to the back of your art. BUT attach some kind of identification that includes your NAME, TITLE, MEDIUM and PRICE.

Show up prepared with your art labeled and ready to be submitted - be a pro.
