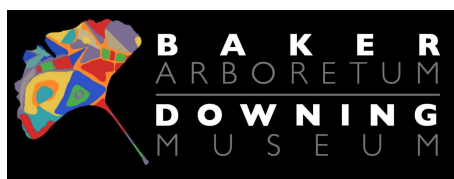

DATES/TIMES TO REMEMBER

On or before Mon., July 24	Entry form and digital image due. Images must be attached with the entry form. Entry forms must be completed online at www.artworkbkg.org . Click on EXHIBITIONS, ALL KENTUCKY. After filling out entry form, pay entry fee.
Thurs., July 27	Acceptance/rejection emails sent.
Fri. & Sat., July 28 & 29	Drop off artwork 10:00 - 3:30 p.m.
Tues., Aug. 8	Opening Reception - 6:00 - 7:30 p.m. - Awards at 6:30 p.m.
Sat., Sept. 9	Pick up art 10:00 - 3:30 p.m.

ENTRY FEE

Fee due - \$25.00 credit/debit or PayPal at the time your entry form is filled out and submitted. Fee may be paid by credit, debit, or PayPal via the ArtWorks website.

GUIDELINES FOR IMAGES

Images should be catalog-ready and high-resolution (at least 5 inches wide (1500px), and at least 300dpi). Images of 2d work should be cropped as close to the edge of the image as possible. Images of 3d work should be taken with a white or neutral background. Images must be saved as a standard .jpg, .png, or .tif image. PLEASE NO .IMG, HEIF, .PAGES, OR HEVC IMAGES (apple devices). Images should be sent with entry form. If your image is too large to send in standard email (typically above 20MB), please use wettransfer.com (jacklesieur@jerryebakerfoundation.org) to send your images.

RULES AND PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

To apply, all entrants must be 18+ years old, live in the state of Kentucky, or are enrolled in a Kentucky state school. **Art previously shown in an ArtWorks Inc. juried exhibition, or at Downing Museum exhibitions, will not be eligible - no exceptions.** One piece of work may be submitted for consideration and must be original and completed within the last two years. Greenware, utilitarian kits and over the counter craft items are not eligible. No "Sip and Paint" themed art accepted. All works created from natural materials must be stable, well-seasoned and insect free.

All works of art must be presented in a professional manner. Wire hangers or wall-mounted cleats **ONLY**. Plexiglass is strongly recommended for works larger than 24 inches.

Maximum size for 2D work is 50” horizontal and 100” vertical - plus framing material. All 3D work must be stable, at or under 36”x36” base, no more than 10’ tall, and not weigh more than 100 pounds. Artists submitting works weighing more than 50 pounds must be on call to help with placement. No video art accepted.

ART SHIPPING AND RETURN

Artists may elect to ship their work to the Downing Museum at 4801 Morgantown Road, Bowling Green, KY 42101 after being notified of acceptance. All accepted works of art **must be RECEIVED by July 29—NO EXCEPTIONS.** At the conclusion of the exhibition, artists may pick up their work in person, or elect to have their work return shipped. All mailed entries requiring return shipping **MUST** include self-addressed, pre-paid postage. The museum will return all works in the package(s) in which they are received within 30 days after the exhibition closes.

AGREEMENT AND LIABILITY

Participating artists agree that submission of work and fee does not guarantee acceptance into the exhibition. Artists agree to hold harmless ArtWorks Inc., the Exhibition/Curating Committee, the Jerry E. Baker Foundation DBA Downing Museum staff and its employees for any loss, theft, or damage that may occur while artwork is on display. The Downing Museum reserves the right to reject works of art that are ineligible for jury, including artwork that is vulgar and/or in poor taste or pieces that do not otherwise meet the exhibition requirements in this prospectus. Artists agree to grant permission to ArtWorks Inc., and the Downing Museum to photograph or video installed artwork for advertising and social media purposes. Artists are responsible for carrying their own insurance on their art.

ArtWorks Inc., and the Downing Museum staff are not involved in the juror’s final decision of accepted and winning art. Artists whose art is accepted into the exhibition agree to exhibit their art until the end of the exhibition - September 9, 2023.

SALES

Art sales are allowed during the exhibition through ArtWorks, Inc. All purchased art will remain until the end of the exhibition. Sales will be made through ArtWorks and a 10% commission will be retained by the organization for future exhibitions. ArtWorks will pay the artists 90% of their sales price within 30 days of the close of the exhibition. Artists are responsible for paying their own taxes on art sold.
