RECONSTRUCTION UPDATE



It has been about eight months since our building suffered severe water damage. Some members might have dropped in to see the extent of the damage first hand, others only saw photos published in our newsletter or on the local news. The rebuilding of the ICC has been a long process for many reasons, but we are now making good progress as you can see in these photos. We took these photos at an Executive Board meeting on September 4th, so they are fairly re-

cent. Remediation has been completed and currently they are working on framing, insulation, and electrical rewiring.

Our struggles with getting fair compensation from the insurance company continue, and even that cannot cover all our expenses, the lost revenue from not being able to use our building, and the exorbitant utility costs during the remediation and reconstruction process. So we plead with you, our ICC family, to reach deeper into your pockets if you are

able, and make a donation to the rebuilding efforts.

We are looking forward to a grand reopening this fall to unveil our beautiful "new" Center. Meantime, please help with the rebuilding of your Italian Cultural Center. her neighbor Gabriele (Marcello Mastroianni). An unexpected bond develops between two people who haven't joined the festivities—a conservative housewife and mother, and a liberal radio broadcaster awaiting deportation. As day fades into night, Antonietta and Gabriele develop a very special relationship that will radically change their perceptions of life, love, and politics.
