2020 Friday Night at the Italian Cinema

LA MAFIA UCCIDE SOLO D'ESTATE (THE MAFIA ONLY KILLS IN THE SUMMER)

La Mafia Uccide Solo D'Estate, is a clever child's eye view of what it was like for normal people living under the mafia's thumb in 1980's and 90's Palermo. Diliberto directed, starred in, and co-wrote this uniquely entertaining take on a very serious theme, the Mafia's killing spree that resulted in the deaths of judges, politicians, and police officers and reached fever pitch with the famous "Maxi-Trial".



The film's protagonist, young Arturo, hears the adults talking and knows that something's going on, but he's decided that Prime Minister Giulio Andreotti's got it covered and there's nothing to worry about. After all, none of the adults seem particularly concerned and "it's winter, and the Mafia only kills people in the summer". If this is just the story that adults tell their children to ease their fears, they seem to (at least want to) believe it too, along with other fantasies about the Mafia and Prime Minister Andreotti. It's easier and safer to believe that danger is Naples' problem, not theirs.

But as the violence escalates, Arturo, like the rest of Palermo, must face the truth, gather courage, and try to stand up to the mob. Diliberto's intertwining of actual footage from the era with the fictional characters really drives home the emotion and sadness of the situation in a very sweet way.



La Transazione (The Transaction) is a 28-minute short, silent, black and white film about immigration. Set in 1893, it follows three Italian sisters at an Ellis Island inspection room who come to America for arranged marriages. The film strongly parallels the current immigration and humanitarian crisis. *La Transazione* is a true American story.

Unless you are a Native American, we all came from somewhere. Some came willingly and some through desperation or bondage. In revisiting our past, we get a glimpse of our future. *La Transazione* opens that door so we can understand the actions of our ancestors. The dreams and heartbreak that molded us. Whether it be cruelty and intolerance or racism and strife, sometimes the tiniest act of kindness can give us a momentary lifeline, helping us regain our purpose and our faith in humanity and ultimately shaping our ideals for future generations.

Powerful performances filled with humor and pathos and a stunning musical score by award winning composers Ellen and Roger Bruno tell this truly American story. The film is currently being submitted to film festivals around the world.

The film's composers, Springfield residents, Ellen and Roger Bruno, will be available for a discussion period following the screening of the film.
