

NIGHTS OF CABIRIA (LE NOTTE DI CABIRIA)

By Federico Fellini (1957) In Italian with English subtitiles

Welcome to the world of Cabiria, a feisty, loud, outspoken and somewhat naïve prostitute waiting for a miracle, and one of the most unforgettable and endearing characters of European cinema. It is Federico Fellini's classic visual study of romantic resilience and faith in human nature.

Cabiria offers herself to the lowest bidder and hears truth in lies. Though she is a prostitute, she tries to search for happiness as best she can, no matter the circumstances. As one who has not been dealt a good hand, she wants to change, but she has been typecast in life as a loser. Yet, she is a loser who always goes on again to look for some happiness.

What is most endearing about this film is that Cabiria handles her misfortune in a childlike manner. She is quick to bounce back from defeat. Fellini does not make the movie a political statement. It is merely a depiction of one person's circumstances, whether created through her own doing or by bad luck, and how Cabiria continues to struggle for a dignified life.

The American Broadway musical comedy and Hollywood picture *Sweet Charity* was inspired by *Nights of Cabiria*.


