Italian Language Classes

Adult Italian Language Classes

The next two sessions for adult Italian language classes have been scheduled.

Beginner I and Beginner II level classes will be offered on Monday nights and will run from 1/9/12 through 3/5/12 and from 3/26/12 through 5/14/12. An additional Beginner I class and an Intermediate level class will be offered on Tuesday nights and will run from 1/10/12 through 3/6/12 and from 3/27/12 through 5/15/12. There will be no classes on 2/20 & 21 and 4/16 & 17 because of school vacations.

All classes are from 6-8 pm for 8 weeks and held at the Italian Cultural Center of Western Mass., Inc., 56 Margaret Street, Springfield, MA. Tuition cost is \$85 for ICC members and \$95 for nonmembers. The course book is available for \$20.00.

"Italiano per Ragazzi"

(Italian for Children)

The ICC will once again offer Italian language classes for children this fall.

The next session will begin on October 29, 2011, and run for 5 weeks through November 26, 2011. All classes will be held on Saturday mornings. Beginner I classes will be from 9:00 - 10:00 am and Beginner II classes will be from 10:05 - 11:05 am. (Children must successfully complete 2 sessions of Beginner I in order to advance to Beginner II.) course book will be required for Beginner II students at a minimal cost

Classes are held at the Italian Cultural Center of Western Mass., Inc., 56 Margaret Street, Springfield, MA.

Children ages 6-12 can be registered by calling the ICC at 413-784-1492. Tuition is \$10 for children whose *parent(s)* have a "Family Membership" and \$20 for children of non-member families. Classes will be offered on a first-come first-served basis. When calling the ICC to register, leave your name, phone number and the number of children that will take the class. Someone will return your call to discuss your child's registration.
