

Dachenhausem and Cote Split Asphalt Mod Doubles

In a rare occurrence, the Nascar Asphalt Modifieds raced double features to make up one of two rain dates from April. The next will be in July.

Ed Dachenhausem paced the field the entire length of the first feature, gaining the advantage at the drop of the green from his second starting position, taking the checkers in the twenty-lap event, despite early challenges from Skip LaPolt.

In the second Asphalt Modified main, John Cote was triumphant over Dachenhausem, as the two started side-by-side in the second row. LaPolt made a hard charge from the ninth starting spot to finish third, in the twenty-lap main.

Nascar Street Stock action, found Joel Murns, Scott Tyler, Emerson Cargain, and Rookie Tucker Katz battling for the win. Katz led the first half of the race, holding off Murns and Tyler. Following the halfway signal, Murns cleared Katz and Tyler, and never looked back, giving fans his famed "Roof Top Shuffle" at the start/finish line. Tyler, Katz, Cargain, and Kyle Welsch completed the top five.

Also victorious for the evening, Josh Wilbur in the Nascar Pro Stocks, Chris Piasecki in the INEX Legends, Glenn Cargain in the 4cyl Trucks, Nicole Nelson in 4cyl Advance, JW Gannon in Modified 4cyls, Shane Turner in 4cyl Novice, Jordan Smith in INEX Bandoleros, Levi Houghtaling in Beginner Bandoleros, and Jerry Kingeter wins the Open Comp Enduro.
