Activation: Hearing God's Voice

Introduction: In order for us to communicate freely and easily with God, it may help to have some understanding about the many ways God speaks. For those familiar with the Seer anointing, we know that God speaks through all five of our spiritual senses: Seeing, Hearing, Touch, Smell and Taste. In the coming days, we will develop activations for all the senses.

Not only does God speak through Sight, Hearing, Touch, Smell and Taste, God speaks in many other ways. For example, God speaks through His written Word, through things in creation, through others around us, through numbers, by dropping a message into our spirit (a knowing), through anointed teachers, and more. God is creative and finds numerous ways to communicate, when we are in communion with Him daily.

This activation is specifically for hearing God's voice. If I may, I will share some of my personal experience hearing God, as an example, for those who have not yet experienced God's voice: I often hear God as a small voice inside, which I have discerned as separate from my own, but at first sounded like my own thoughts. From what I have heard from many who have shared as to how they hear God, this way seems the most common way we hear God's voice regularly. I have heard the audible voice of each of the Three as well (Father, Jesus and Holy Spirit), over the years, however, these times have not been as frequent and are usually during the night, as I am coming out of a dream, or half awake. I have also experienced the voice of the Holy Spirit often, speaking to my spirit, where it is a "knowing" or "sensing", but I do not hear specific words. It is similar to what it feels to have an "idea" or simply a feeling of suddenly knowing something I had not known previously. It is more of a "leading", often knowing that this is the right way to go or the right thing to say in the moment. I hope describing some of the ways we "hear" God helps, as you enter into your personal experience of hearing Him, leading you into this activation. Your experience will be uniquely yours.

Please find a comfortable room, where you will not be disturbed, relax and soak in God's presence.

~~~First: Pray this prayer, or one in your own words:

God, I place myself in Your hands, in total trust right now. Open my ears to hear Your voice in whatever way You feel is the best way for us to begin. I long to hear what You have to say to me personally, in these moments. I am hungry for more of You, and I long to become Your friend, just as I consider You my friend. We read in Matthew 7:7 where Jesus says: "Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you." I am asking, seeking and knocking Lord. Thank You for opening my ears, and for all You are about to do as You teach me to hear You clearly for Your glory, in Jesus' name...AMEN.

~~~Second: Relax, close your eyes and listen. Allow yourself to be putty in God's hands, as He opens your ears to hear Him. If you hear Him say something and are wondering if it was God or your own thoughts, ask Him immediately. He will confirm so that you know. Do not allow worry or unease to enter this space. Simply let yourself go. This is a time to have fun and engage in any kind of conversation He leads. Remember that He loves to have fun with us, so He may even make you laugh in these precious moments. Our God is amazing. Enjoy all He has for you today. ~~~~Third: Stay in God's presence as long as you wish and never get discouraged if the time goes much differently than you expected. He is the God of surprise. He has a plan and knows how you best learn. There is always tomorrow, and the more time you spend with Him, the easier this will become. This develops over time. He trains us how to hear Him.

~God, I thank You for this person who is seeking You right now, who longs to hear Your voice. I pray Your blessing over all ears, to hear You today and in all the days to come, in Jesus' name! <3
