## **CONTACT INFORMATION**

M-DCPS has the ability to communicate accurately and efficiently with parents through voice, text, and email messages. It's important that your child's school has the most current contact information. Parents can update their details by contacting their child's principal. #### **IMMUNIZATIONS**

Parents are urged to check their children's immunization records to see if they are due for any mandated school entry vaccines. All M-DCPS students are required to have the mandatory school age vaccines for the 2020-2021 school year, including those participating exclusively via MSO.



#### **ONLINE ACCESS**

In preparation of the first day of school via MSO, all students are asked to visit www.dadeschools.net to log in to the Student Portal using their Student ID and Password on a personal or District-issued device to confirm access. If they are unable to access their account, the student should contact their school for assistance.



### **SCHOOL SUPPLIES**

Students will need typical school supplies such as paper and pencils to write things down, take notes, solve math problems, as well as any other supplies that their teachers might indicate are necessary for the class. They will also need a computer with a camera, a microphone, and internet access. Parents should check their child's school website or contact the school for supply lists.



#### UNIFORMS

During Stage I and II on MSO, uniforms are encouraged. The uniform policy will be enforced and face coverings will be required in the Schoolhouse Model during Stage II.



# **MEALS**

Parents are encouraged to apply for free and reduced-price lunch at www.nutrition.dadeschools.net. Meals will be available in Stage I and Stage II. Distribution sites and specific times for pick-up will be shared as soon as that information becomes available. Breakfast is free for all students.



### **FAMILY ENGAGEMENT**
