

Firearms Repair Safety Guidelines

1. Treat all Firearms as if they are loaded until you have thoroughly checked them more than one time
2. Never point an assembled firearm at anything you are not willing to kill or destroy
3. Be sure of what is behind or beyond anything at which you point an assembled firearm
4. Keep your finger off the trigger and out of the trigger guard until you have thoroughly complied with the three previous rules
5. Never, ever, test a firearm with live ammo, unless you are in a place where it is safe and legal to fire a weapon. No ammo in the repair / modification area.
6. Check all safety and ignition systems when the gun is unloaded
7. We recommend that all initial live fire testing be done with a single round in the firearm
8. Wear safety glasses. There are lots of parts in your gun that can put your eye out!
