



# Am I OK?

In the 1970's Denver running back Floyd Little was facing off against the big bad linebacker Dick Butkus. When describing a collision he said, "Dick Butkus hit me so hard my body almost liquified." Not wanting to look weak, Little pulled himself up quickly as if nothing had happened.

Butkus then said to him, "You okay?" Floyd Little said, "Yeah of course." Then Butkus replied, "Well if you're okay, why are you in our huddle?" He'd been hit so hard that he had followed him into the Bears' huddle.
