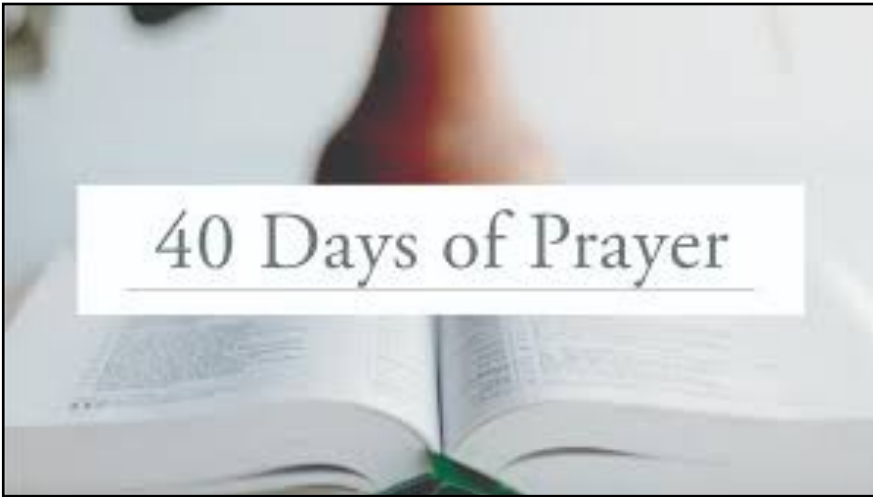
## *Welcome to Lomax!*
