Refrain from name-calling. Be kind, especially when a student is wrong or confused. Pray for self and class. Teach truth and practice what you teach. Make the class relevant and practical. When studying complex issues, always encourage the safest course. Give homework. Be flexible in your teaching methods.

#### TO BE A GREAT STUDENT

Sincerely love God, His Word and those in the class Be prepared to learn, remember, apply and teach to others. Arrive early.

Don't always sit with the same people.

Participate but never dominate - be positive or kind in your comments. Never use class time to discuss church business.

Pray for the class and the teacher.

Support the teacher at every opportunity (They are volunteers) Bring visitors with you.

Meet visitors.

Check on absentees.

When dealing with error, follow the example of Aguilla & Priscilla. Bring your Bible, mark Scriptures, take notes.


