



- We are people who truly believe that Jesus is God's only begotten Son (John 3: 16), that He actually came down from Him as our Savior and put our lives in His hands.
- We have been baptized by immersion into the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit (Matthew 28:19), for the remission of our sins and to receive the gift of the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:38).
- We have not attained perfection nor do we know and understand all things in God's Word, but we ever strive to please the Master (Philippians 3: 12-14) and search the Scriptures daily to determine what He wills for our lives (Acts 17:11).
- We are pilgrims on a life-long journey in search of a heavenly city whose builder and maker is God (Hebrews 11:10).
- Since Jesus has been given all authority in heaven and on earth (Matthew 28:18) and since His word will judge us in the last day (John 12:48), we are content to follow the New Testament of Christ as our only rule of faith and worship.

- We are a people who care for each other. We bear one another's burdens as we fulfill the law of Christ (Galatians 6:2).
- In our worship we honor the Father and Son. In our work we seek to save those who are lost in sin by teaching them about Christ (Luke 19:10; Mark 16:15-16). We labor that God's will shall be done on earth as it is in heaven (Matthew 6:10).
