As many of you know since 1993 I have been very involved with the mission work in Kenya. I am excited to share my upcoming plans to travel to Nairobi. I will leave on November 3, 2023 and return on November 16, 2023. While in Kenya, I will work with the Nakuru Christian





Preaching School (N.C.P.S.), Nairobi Church of Christ Eastleigh (N.C.C.E), the Institute for Practical Christian Ministry (I.P.C.M.), and the Kenyan Christian Industrial Training Institute (K.C.I.T.I). N.C.C.E., the nucleus of all of these important works, is involved in the com-

munity through various evangelistic efforts. N.C.P.S. and I.P.C.M. trains preachers and evangelists from all over East Africa. K.C.I.T.I. is the Church of Christ trade school that provides quality education at an affordable cost so that individuals have greater op-

portunity to succeed in the work place. Students, while attending college are required to take Bible classes. This has helped plant seed and has brought many to Christ. The school is a great outreach and evangelistic tool in East Africa. I am blessed to be on the Board of Governors for this college.





While in Kenya I will be conducting spiritual leadership training seminars at each institution. This year I will be taking fellow minister and a former Freed Hardeman University Men's Soccer Coach, Diego Rojas, with me.

He will help conduct the seminars with the preaching schools. Along with the preaching seminars, we will host a three day outreach soccer clinic with for the young people in the inner-city and slum areas around the church. This will give us opportunity to not just teach soccer, but also to teach Christ through actions and through Bible lessons and devotionals we will conduct each day. Please keep this trip and our efforts in your prayers as we try to raise the rest of the funds needed, and as we make preparations for the efforts ahead of us.

We are glad to have you visiting with us today! You are welcome here. We know you have a choice of where to worship, and you chose to be with us today — thank you.


At Lomax we want to be the church we read about in the Bible. Our goal is to glorify God with our worship and with our lives and to point people to Jesus Christ.


