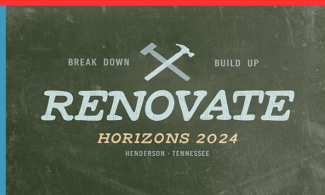

SUMMER CAMPS

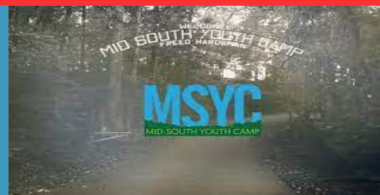
