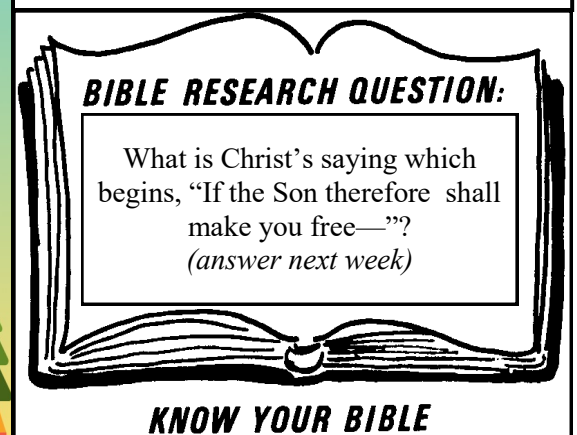
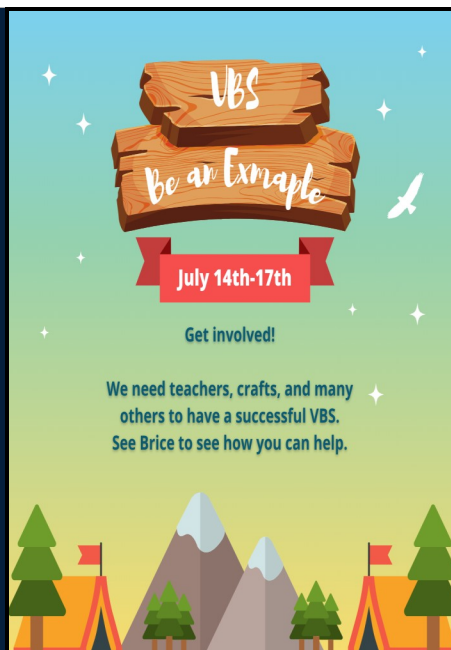
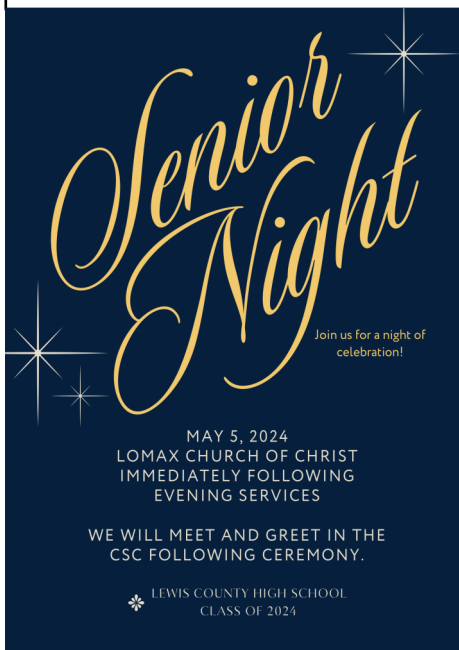

SUMMER CAMPS!

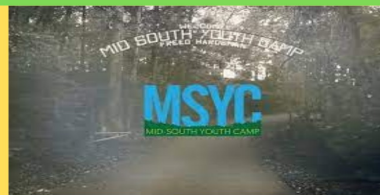
