# The Importance of Godly Teachers

Few roles in the church have as lasting an impact as those who teach God's Word, especially to our children. Bible class teachers are more than lesson presenters; they are spiritual guides shaping hearts, planting seeds of faith, and modeling Christlike living. The stories, scriptures, and examples taught in those early years often remain in a child's heart for a lifetime.

Think for a moment: the faith you hold today may have been nurtured by a dedicated teacher who patiently explained Bible truths, encouraged questions, and lived out their own faith in front of you. Godly teachers are a vital part of fulfilling the Great Commission (Matthew 28:19–20), ensuring that the next generation knows the Lord and His Word (Deuteronomy 6:6–7).

The work is not always easy. It requires preparation, prayer, and a love for both God and His people. Yet the rewards are eternal. In 3 John 4, John wrote, "I have no greater joy than to hear that my children are walking in the truth." That joy belongs to every teacher who sees their students grow into faithful servants of Christ.

We are so thankful for our teachers, for the love, dedication, and self-less work they do for our young people. We are blessed! However, this important work cannot rest on the shoulders of a few. Our Bible classes need more willing hearts and hands. If you are able to read, study, and share your faith, you can make a difference. The church needs members, men and women, young and old, who will step up, teach, and invest in the spiritual future of our children.

Pray about your role. Ask God to use your abilities, however small you think they may be, for His glory. The need is great, the opportunity is now, and the eternal impact is beyond measure. Will you answer the call to teach?



In Luke 7:11-17, there is reported a very special interaction between Jesus and a widow who was now grieving the loss of her only son. Apparently the whole town of Nain felt sorry for her as they were mourning with her. Jesus had compassion on her—He raised her son from the dead and gave him back to his mother.

Can you imagine the scene? This mother was given a second chance. I wonder what she did. I wonder what she said. Do you think she used the days differently now? Do you think she valued her time with her son differently now? Do you think she spoke to her son differently now? Do you think she used the time to regularly talk to him about the Lord (Deut. 6:4-9)?
