## The Incredible Love of God

One of the greatest truths in all of Scripture is that "God is love" (1 John 4:8). His love is not based on our worthiness or performance but flows from His very nature. From the beginning of time, God has been reaching out to His people with steadfast love, calling them into relationship with Him.

John 3:16 reminds us, "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life." This verse tells us two important truths: God's love is universal, it is for the whole world, and God's love is sacrificial, He gave His Son for us. No one is beyond the reach of that love.

Paul describes the depth of God's love in Romans 5:8: "But God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us." Unlike human love, which can be fragile or conditional, God's love is steadfast and unchanging. Even in our weakness and rebellion, He loved us enough to send Jesus to the cross.

God's love is also transforming. Paul prayed that Christians might "know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge" (Ephesians 3:19). When we grasp how deeply we are loved, it changes how we see ourselves and how we treat others. His love frees us from fear, gives us confidence, and motivates us to serve with joy.

Here is the challenge: Don't just believe in the love of God, live in it. Share it. Let it shape your words, your choices, and your relationships this week. John also wrote, "Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another" (1 John 4:11). God's love is too great to keep to ourselves, let's show it to the world.




