"Why God Wants Us to Sing"

During the Battle of the Bulge in World War II, a group of weary American soldiers huddled together in a forest clearing. Cold, hungry, and afraid, they quietly waited for the next command. One young soldier began to hum an old hymn he had learned as a child, "Abide with Me." Slowly, others joined in. Before long, that small band of warriors, standing in the shadow of death, were singing together with trembling voices.

They didn't have instruments.

They didn't have perfect pitch.

But they had faith, and their singing brought comfort, courage, and the presence of God.

Why does God want His church to sing?

Because singing isn't just tradition, it's transformation. When the church lifts its voice, something powerful happens. According to Ephesians 5:19, we sing to the Lord and to each other.

And in Colossians 3:16, Paul says that through singing we teach and admonish one another with wisdom.

Singing is not about performance.

It's about participation.

It teaches doctrine

It encourages hearts

It glorifies God

And it reminds us that every voice matters






