

You know what next week is? Happy Turkey Day, also called Thanksgiving. Have you ever seen the articles in the paper the kindergarten submits for preparing and cooking a Turkey? They are really funny.

Here is our Turkey preparation the grandkids and I have done the past few years. Kosher salt & freshly ground pepper, 2 tablespoons finely chopped fresh thyme, plus 8 sprigs, 2 tablespoons finely chopped fresh rosemary plus 4 sprigs, 12 to 14 pound turkey remove neck and giblets, 2 head garlic halved, 2 lemons (1 halved, 1 sliced), 4 bay leaves, 1 large shallot, quartered, ½ cup extra-virgin olive oil, and there is a lot more day before dry-brine the turkey, etc. I need a dictionary for some of this stuff. Being prepared means we do those things necessary to have our Thanksgiving meal.
