
We are glad to have you visiting with us today! You are welcome here. We know you have a choice of where to worship, and you chose to be with us today — thank you.




June 29th, 2012, you know how I like to tell you about a day in history, well this day was the hottest in Tennessee ever recorded 103 degrees. However, if you are all in to record breaking, we have a "heat dome" over us we might break the record this week. A "heat dome" isn't technically a scientific term and is a fairly new term that has gained popularity in recent years. It is a condition that occurs when a persistent region of high pressure traps heat over a certain area for a period of time, according to [the American Meteorological Society](#). We talk about the weather and predicting it and apparently in Jesus day they did the same. 
