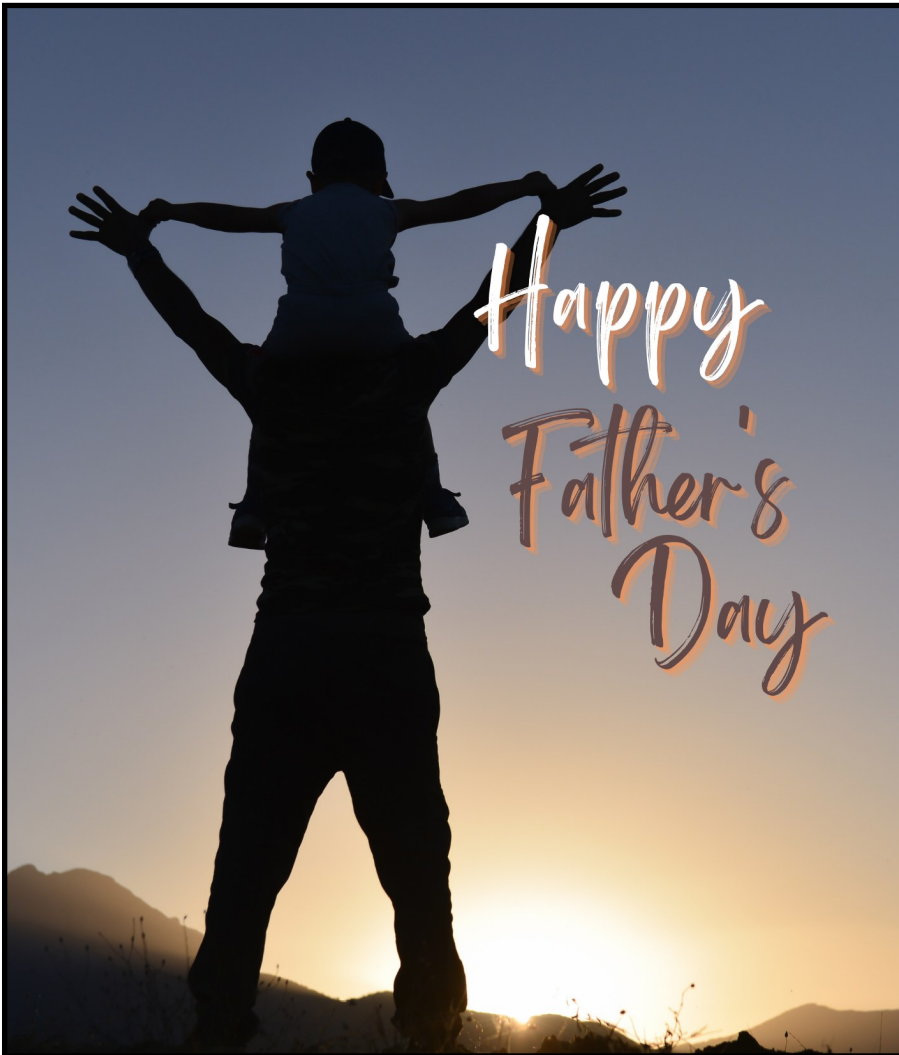

This week in history June 23, 1868 Christopher Latham Sholes got a patent. A patent that would ripple and stay with us in some way all the way to today. He invented the typewriter.


