What Makes a Christian Distinct?

Today the word *Christian* is used so broadly in our world. Many here in the Bible Belt are quick to label themselves as "Christian" without truly living and practicing the life of one. This contributes to the negative and critical view many have towards Christianity. Yet, the Bible offers a clear and compelling picture of what sets true followers of Christ apart. Being a Christian is more than a label, it's a transformed life. After all Jesus didn't call His disciples to blend in, but to stand out for the right reasons.

One of the most distinctive characteristics of a born again Christian is **love**. Jesus said, "By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another" (John 13:35, ESV). Not just any love, but selfless, sacrificial love that mirrors Christ's. This love reaches across social, racial, and political divides and forgives even when it's hard.

Another key trait is **holiness**. Peter writes, "But as he who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct" (1 Peter 1:15). Holiness isn't about perfection—it's about being set apart, resisting the pull of sin, and choosing God's way over the world's. Christians are called to shine like lights in a dark world (Philippians 2:15), showing integrity, honesty, and purity in every area of life.

Humility is also central. Jesus, the Son of God, came not to be served but to serve (Matthew 20:28). Christians are to reflect Him by putting others before themselves, rejecting pride, and serving with joy—even when no one's watching.

And finally, true Christians are marked by **faithful obedience**. James tells us that faith without works is dead (James 2:17). A real Christian doesn't just talk about faith—they live it out, consistently following God's Word and bearing the fruit of the Spirit (Galatians 5:22-23).

Being a Christian isn't just about what we believe, it's about how we live. Let your life reflect the One who saved you. Love deeply, live holy, walk humbly, and obey faithfully. That's what makes a Christian truly distinct.

We are glad to have you visiting with us today! You are welcome here. We know you have a choice of where to worship, and you chose to be with us today — thank you.


At Lomax we want to be the church we read about in the Bible. Our goal is to glorify God with our worship and with our lives and to point people to Jesus Christ.




