Cash prizes, a commemorative gift, and bragging rights will be bestowed upon the finalists.

Entrants must demonstrate an impact within the Driftless Region of southwest central Wisconsin, southeast Minnesota, northeast Iowa, or northwest Illinois. There are other groups recognizing sustainability in parts of the region, said Jacobson, but SDI is the only

one encompassing the entire Driftless Area.

Celebrating a decade of programming, SDI is a 501(c)3 governed by a board with representatives from all four Driftless states.
