Supplies/Tools Needed (available for purchase at Thumb Sewing):

- Bring **EVERYTHING** that came with your serger, all cover plates, spool holders, tweezers, stylus, needle threaders, accessory box, and the **MANUAL**
- Spare serger needles (these are different than sewing machine needles)
- 4 cones of serger thread- 1 of them **MUST** be different than the other 3.

Supplies Needed (NOT available at Thumb Sewing)

Clear page sleeves (12 should be enough for class)
Pen or pencil for writing and a stapler.
3-ring binder (1 ½ to 2 inches)

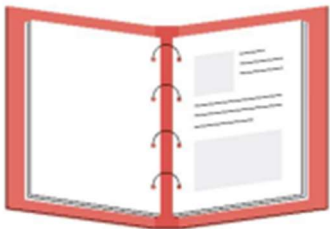
Cindy Peck
