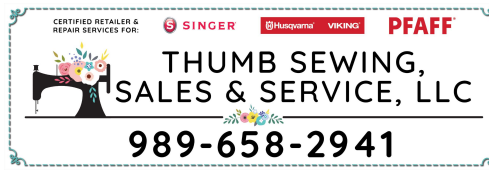

Supplies/Tools Needed (available for purchase at Thumb Sewing):

2 fat quarters
12" zipper to match fabric
Matching thread
Scissors
Pins
Spare Needles
¼ yard medium weight fusible interfacing ⅓ yard iron on adhesive (Steam-a-Seam II, Wonder Under, or other brand).
Optional: ¼ yard ⅝ inch grosgrain ribbon
Cutting mat, rotary cutter, quilting ruler***also available for use during the class
Sewing machine with zipper foot (bring all accessories and instruction book)

Tools available for use during the class/workshop:

Cutting mat, rotary cutter, quilting ruler, iron

About the Educator:

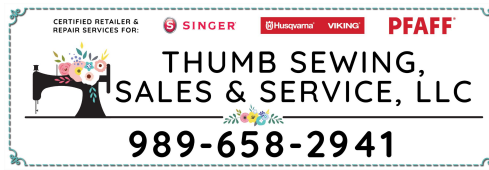
