Supplies/Tools Needed (available for purchase at Thumb Sewing):

Kitchen Towel (plain color)

Fabric

¼ yard fusible adhesive for applique

¼ yard tearaway stabilizer

2 fabrics for ruffles- coordinate with towel color 5" by width of the fabric each

1 yard grosgrain ribbon to match ruffle fabric (1/8" to 1" wide)

Scraps of fabric (or ¼ yard each of applique fabrics)

Sewing thread to match ruffle fabric or towel.

60 WT bobbin thread

Decorative rayon or polyester thread for applique to match or contrast with applique fabric

Basic Sewing Supplies Needed:

Pins or clips

Spare Needles

Coordinating Thread

Cutting mat, rotary cutter, quilting ruler

Iron

Tools available for use during the class/workshop:

Cutting mat, rotary cutter, quilting ruler, iron

About the Educator:



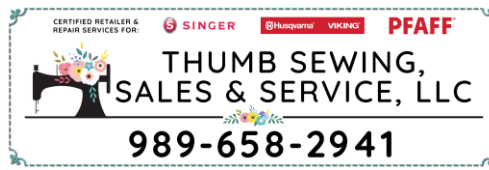
